What stops young people from finding work

- >> Too few entry-level jobs available.
- >> Hard to get the first job without experience.
- >> No professional networks to support job search.
- >> Difficult to stand out and prove skills.

>> this leads to sense of exclusion: shame and feelings of worthlessness; not feeling a part of society.
